**Name:** Henry

**Age:** 31

**Profession:** private secretary

**Relation to the victim:** You are Lord Stanford's private secretary. You take care of his papers and his money. You met him in South Africa.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were going to London by train.

**Information about the crime?** You have no information: you were not there.

**Surname:** GILLS

**Name:** Elizabeth

**Age:** 26

**Profession:** cook

**Relation to the victim:** You are Lord Standford's cook.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were in the kitchen, you were preparing dinner.

**Information about the crime?** You have got information about the office: the office is usually locked (= *fermé à clé*). Only the maid, the warden, the cleaning woman, the secretary, the gardener and the driver have access to Lord Standford's office.

**Surname:** SMITH

**Name:** Cathy

**Age:** 45

**Profession:** banker

**Relation to the victim:** Lord Standford often came to the bank to talk about his money.

**What were you doing when it happened?** I was working at the bank.

**Information about the crime?** Lord Standford had money problems. A large sum (= *somme*) of money had disappeared.

**Surname:** LADY HARBORD

**Name:** Julia

**Age:** It's a secret!

**Profession:** You're a Lady come on! You can't have a job!

**Relation to the victim:** You have been Lord Standford's mistress for three years. A deep, loving relationship!

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were shopping in Fishguard. You were not in the property! Your affair was a secret!

**Information about the crime?** None.

**Surname:** KINSTEY

**Name:** George

**Age:** 55

**Profession:** gardener

**Relation to the victim:** You have been Lord Standford's gardener for 25 years!

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were gardening.

**Information about the crime?** You were under the window when Lord Standford fell out. You saw a man.

**Surname:** GORE

**Name:** John

**Age:** 65

**Profession:** Mayor of Fishguard

**Relation to the victim:** you have known Lord Standford for a long time; he is the biggest tax payer of the city.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were at the train station; you were talking to the train drivers. There was a big technical problem; no trains were running (= working) that day.

**Information about the crime?** None.

**Surname:** BREEM

**Name:** Kenneth

**Age:** 49

**Profession:** journalist for *the Fishguard Chronicle*

**Relation to the victim:** You are a very good friend of Lord Standford.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were working at home for *the Fishguard Chronicle*.

**Information about the crime?** None.

**Surname:** KAYLEY

**Name:** Bruce

**Age:** 54

**Profession:** retired

**Relation to the victim:** You are one of Lord Standford's friends.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were playing golf with your wife.

**Information about the crime?** The object which has been found... this animal... it's a springbok. It's a symbol of South Africa.

**Surname:** KAYLEY

**Name:** Sarah

**Age:** 52

**Profession:** none

**Relation to the victim:** You are Bruce Kayley's wife. You are a friend of Lord Standford.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were playing golf with your husband.

**Information about the crime?** None.

**Surname:** IRENE

**Name:** Isabel

**Age:** 42

**Profession:** cleaning woman

**Relation to the victim:** You have been Lord Stanford's cleaning woman for 20 years!

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were cleaning the living room and chatting with Lady Stanford.

**Information about the crime?** You heard a man's voice coming from the office upstairs.

**Surname:** SCHOLAR

**Name:** Rachel

**Age:** 33

**Profession:** lawyer

**Relation to the victim:** You were Lord Stanford's lawyer.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were working.

**Information about the crime?** You haven't got any information but you know that Lord Stanford wanted to fire (= renvoyer) an employee.

**Surname:** FITCH

**Name:** Ursula

**Age:** 27

**Profession:** maid

**Relation to the victim:** You have been Lord Stanford's maid for 5 years.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were doing the laundry (= la lessive) next to the kitchen.

**Information about the crime?** You haven't got any information but you know that Lord Stanford's daughter can't come to the property any more.

**Surname:** GALLY

**Name:** Michelle

**Age:** 52

**Profession:** diplomat

**Relation to the victim:** You spent time with Lord Standford in South Africa.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were having dinner in a restaurant with your family.

**Information about the crime?** You haven't got any information but you know that Lord Standford's daughter was very angry when she learned about the hidden son.

**Surname:** SIGHT

**Name:** Roger

**Age:** 41

**Profession:** warden

**Relation to the victim:** you have been the warden of the property for 20 years. You know the place very well.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were helping Mr Tebogo (the driver) to clean the car.

**Information about the crime?** You know who was on the property when it happened. The maid, the cleaning woman, the gardener, the secretary, the driver and the cook were there.

**Surname:** PINCH

**Name:** Arthur

**Age:** 37

**Profession:** tailor

**Relation to the victim:** You have been Lord Standford's tailor for 8 years.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were working in your shop, in Fishguard.

**Information about the crime?** Lord Standford cancelled (= annulé) an appointment (= rendez-vous) with you on the day of the crime because he had something important to do.

**Name:** William

**Age:** 49

**Profession:** doctor

**Relation to the victim:** You have been Lord Stanford's doctor for 10 years.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were operating on a patient.

**Information about the crime?** Lord Stanford was very anxious several days before the crime. He talked to me about a "betrayal".

**Surname:** STANDFORD

**Name:** Ann

**Age:** 29

**Profession:** none

**Relation to the victim:** You are Lord Stanford's only daughter.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were shopping in Fishguard with your aunt (=tante), Mary Stanford.

**Information about the crime?** Your brother (well, your father's hidden son) must have killed him! You were so angry he had a son!

**Surname:** TEBEGO

**Name:** Alan

**Age:** 39

**Profession:** driver

**Relation to the victim:** You were born in South Africa. You have been Lord Stanford's driver since you met him in South Africa.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were cleaning Lord Stanford's car.

**Information about the crime?** None.

**Surname:** STANDFORD

**Name:** Mary

**Age:** 51

**Profession:** editor

**Relation to the victim:** You are Lord Standford's sister

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were shopping with Ann Standford (=your niece) in Fishguard.

**Information about the crime?** You haven't got any information about the crime but you suspect someone: Lord Standford' hidden son – Mr Irene. He is a strange man.

**Surname:** IRENE

**Name:** Harry

**Age:** 18

**Profession:** student

**Relation to the victim:** You are Lord Standford's hidden son. And the cleaning woman's son too.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were driving to the property to see your mother.

**Information about the crime?** You think Ann Standford is the murderer. She is a strange woman.

**Surname:** LADY STANDFORD

**Age:** Doesn't want to tell

**Profession:** None

**Relation to the victim:** You are Lord Standford's wife. You are now a widow.

**What were you doing when it happened?** You were talking to Isabel, the cleaning woman.

**Information about the crime?** Your husband was so weird these days, he spent so much time in his office.
